

BLESSED SACRAMENT SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST 2017-18

All students in Grades 2-8 are required to have an assignment pad. This year the cost will come from the \$75.00 activity fee. Students will receive their assignment pad on the first day of school.

All Grades: Book covers are required for all textbooks.

All Grades: Mark your name on all items with permanent marker.

KINDERGARTEN: Book bag or backpack, 1 bottle of Elmer's white school glue, 10 glue sticks, 1 box of crayons (no more than 24), 1 box of **primary** color Crayola classic color markers (washable, broad tip no skinny markers), 1 package of #2 yellow pencils – sharpened, 3 single subject spiral notebook, 2 pink erasers, Expo markers, 3 box of tissues, 500+ package of napkins, one bottle of hand sanitizer, container of 75 Clorox or Lysol wipes, “old” clean pair of socks, 2 rolls of paper towels, 1 pk. Magnetic letters, small, over the ear headphones (No Buds) for computer class. According to last name A-M please bring 409 spray cleaner, N-Z please bring quart size Ziploc baggies. **Please remember to stock up on crayons, glue sticks, and markers. They will need to be replaced 2 or 3 times during the year.**

GRADE ONE: Book bag or back pack, 36 sharpened #2 yellow pencils, 1 box of crayons (no more than 24), 1 box of crayons classic color markers (washable), pencil case (hard case or zippered bank bag that can hold crayons, markers, pencils, etc), 2 sturdy pocket folders, 2 single subject notebooks (wide ruled), scissors, 12 glue sticks, 2 pink erasers (not pencil top kind), 4 dry erase markers, 3 boxes of tissues, addition and subtraction flash cards (facts up to 20), 2 highlighters, 1 container (75 count or larger) of disinfecting wipes, 1 roll of paper towels, 1 standard size clip board, 1 large hand sanitizer, 1 box sandwich zip lock bags, 1 box quart zip lock bags, 3 cloth book covers. First graders do not need gym clothes.

SECOND GRADE: 1 ten pack of #2 sharpened pencils, erasers, pencil top and large pink eraser, large sturdy zippered pencil case, 24 pack of crayons, scissors, glue sticks (10), bottle of glue, classic markers, 2 highlighters, cm/in ruler, 3-1 subject wide ruled notebooks, 6 bottom pocket folders, 1 standard sized clipboard, 3 boxes of Kleenex, 2 dry erase markers, addition and subtraction flash cards, 1 roll of paper towels, 2 containers of disinfecting wipes, Ziploc baggies (gallon, quart, sandwich, or snack) , one bottle of hand sanitizer. Gym uniform and gym bag. One set of small headphones for computer class.

THIRD GRADE: Pencils, erasers, soft pencil case, 24 pack of crayons, one pack of markers (no more than 12 in a pack), 1 standard sized clip board, wooden ruler cm/metric, medium size Elmer's glue (white), scissors, one five subject wide ruled notebook, four pocket folders, backpack, two boxes of Kleenex, wide ruled loose leaf, one wide ruled composition notebook for journal writing, one highlighter, 1 container of disinfecting wipes, dry erase markers, one bottle of hand sanitizer, one pencil sharpener, old clean sock to erase with. 6 - Cloth Book Covers. Please label school supplies with your name before the first day of school. No binders, no mechanical pencils, no glue sticks. Erasable pens will be needed in January.

FOURTH GRADE: 1 zippered soft pencil case, 7 folders with pockets (Do Not Label), loose leaf paper (standard ruled No college ruled), 8 one subject notebooks (Do Not Label), 10- blue or black pens (no click), one red pen, one package of #2 yellow sharpened pencils (No mechanical), 1 box of 24 crayons, colored pencil set, white or clear Elmer's glue, 1 wooden ruler (standard and metric), thin marker set, 1 highlighter, scissors (metal, sharp point – Crayola or Fiskars), 2 boxes of Kleenex, 1 hard cover journal book, 1 ultra fine point black sharpie, 1 clear protractor, 1 simple calculator (for standardized tests), large container of disinfecting wipes, 1 shoe box (keep at home until needed), 2 packs of index cards, and 6 book covers. One **good quality** recorder for Music. **DO NOT MARK BOOKS AS WE WILL DO ALL THAT ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.** (No: gel pens, glitter glue, pencil sharpeners, loose-leaf binders or accordion folders)

GRADE FIVE: Book bag, 2 composition books (usually black and white), zippered pencil case equipped with 6- #2 pencils sharpened, 2 blue or black ball point pens (no click pens), ruler, loose leaf paper (no college ruled), 1 accordion folder, 9 spiral notebooks (no college ruled – do not buy 3 or 5 subject notebooks, do not buy notebooks with colored paper), scissors, bottle of glue , 24 or less box of crayons, a pack of 8 markers, colored pencils, 3 boxes of tissues, 2 containers of disinfecting wipes. No ring binders, no trapper keepers. One **good quality** recorder for Music.

MIDDLE SCHOOL (Grades 6-8)

GENERAL SUPPLIES:

Book bag, gym bag (large enough for the gym uniform, sneakers and deodorant), zippered pencil case (no boxes), blue and black pens, red pens, pencils, erasers (bar and pencil top), 1 hand pencil sharpener (with a section to collect shavings), 1 ruler cm/in., 2 packs of loose-leaf paper, 1 small bottle of Elmer's liquid glue, 1 highlighter, scissors, 1 box of 24 Crayola crayons, 1 box of Crayola Classic thin markers, 1 box of 12 Crayola colored pencils, 1 black extra fine sharpie marker, 1 black regular sharpie marker, 1 multi-subject accordion file folder, 1 Scientific calculator TI-30XA, 1 flash drive, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer, 3 boxes of tissues, 1 container of disinfecting wipes and/or roll of paper towels.

EIGHTH GRADE ONLY- \$20.00 graduation fee due the first week of school.

SUBJECT SUPPLIES:

RELIGION: 1 New American Bible (If not purchased in 6th grade. Cost will come from \$75 activity fee), 1 Composition Notebook

ENGLISH: one inch flexible 3 metal ring binder with dividers and loose-leaf, index cards & 1 subject notebook

MATH: one inch flexible 3 metal ring binder with dividers and loose-leaf

SCIENCE: one inch flexible 3 metal ring binder with dividers and loose-leaf

SOCIAL STUDIES: one inch flexible 3 metal ring binder with dividers and loose-leaf, two extra fine sharpie markers, 1 subject notebook

LITERATURE: 1 subject notebook

VOCABULARY: 1 subject notebook, 1 pack of index cards

COMPUTER: All students: one set of headphones (may be purchased at dollar store). Grades 4-8: one 2-pocket folder.

MUSIC: Grades 1-4 double pocket folder just for music. Grades 5-6-7-8: Section in accordion folder with loose-leaf paper. Supplies for band will be available at the beginning of the school year.

Physical Education: Grades 2-8: a Blessed Sacrament School Phys. Ed. uniform (BSS gold gym shirt which is purchased through BSS school store (\$8.50), and black shorts), only athletic type gym shoes are accepted. Grades K-1 are required to wear gym shoes, not the gym uniform. No jewelry, except post earring, is permitted to be worn during gym classes.

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PRE 2 SUPPLY LIST

If your child is still in diapers, you will need to send in diapers and wipes to keep in the cubby.

PRE 3 SUPPLY LIST

1. Three bottles/cans of juice and three snacks (examples: packages of **crackers, granola bars, pretzels, etc.**). **The quantity should be enough** to serve the whole class (approximately 20 students). Please label the juice and snacks with your child's name. We will need juice and snacks again after the Christmas break.
2. A change of clothes (including underwear) to be kept at school in case of an accident. Please send these clothes in a one gallon zip lock bag (labeled with your child's name) on the first day.
3. A book bag must be sent **every day** with your child. The book bag must be large enough to accommodate a one inch size binder (which is provided by the preschool). Please have your child's name visible on the **outside** of the book bag.
4. Additional supplies to be used in the classroom:
 - 4 rolls of paper towels
 - 1 container of baby wipes
 - 2 cans of Lysol disinfectant spray
 - 1 container of Clorox/Lysol disinfecting wipes
 - 1 all-purpose antibacterial spray cleaner (for use on tables)
 - 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
 - 2 boxes of tissues

*Please send these additional supplies during the first week of school in a bag labeled with your child's name. **Thank you!** ** If your child is enrolled in the PM Enrichment Program (11:00 am – 2:45 pm), s/he will also need a lunch box (labeled with name on the outside) for packed lunches. Lunches will be stored in a refrigerator upon arrival. Hot lunches

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and milk are available for purchase in the cafeteria. A child sized sleeping bag/blanket and small pillow that can be kept at school for rest time will also be needed.

PRE 4 SUPPLIES LIST

Things your preschooler will need:

1. Three bottles of juice and three snacks. (20 students per class) Please label juice and snacks with your child's name. A good rule is to pick a snack your child likes to eat or drink. *We will need juice and snacks again after Christmas break.
2. A one gallon zip lock bag with a change of clothes for your child. Please mark the bag with their name. These bags will be kept at school in case they have an accident. Please send this in as soon as possible.
3. A backpack or book bag large enough to accommodate our preschool daily binders (BEAR Book) and their artwork. Please have your child's name is visible on the outside of the book bag. Please no backpacks on wheels.
4. Additional Supplies to be used in the classroom:
 - 4 glue sticks
 - 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
 - 1 can of disinfecting spray (example- Lysol)
 - 1 roll of paper towels
 - 3 packs of disinfecting wipes
 - 1 container of baby wipes
 - 2 boxes of tissues

** If your child will be eating lunch at school, they can purchase a hot lunch in the cafeteria or you can pack them a lunch. (please put their name on the outside of their lunch box). We have a refrigerator to keep lunches cold. They can also purchase milk in the cafeteria.

1. 10 Glue Sticks
2. 2 Bottles of Hand Sanitizer
3. 2 Rolls of Paper Towels
4. 1 Container of Disinfecting Wipes
5. 1 Container of Baby Wipes
6. Zip lock bags (quart or gallon)

8. Book bag big enough to accommodate a folder (with name on the OUTSIDE)
9. Lunch box (with name on the OUTSIDE)
10. Sleeping bag/blanket – in a durable bag (with name on it)
11. Head phones for Computer Class (Not the small ear buds that go inside the ear please.)
12. 3 Juices and 4 Snacks – enough for the entire class (We will need to restock after Christmas.)
13. A change of clothing in a zip lock bag with their name on the bag (Just in case of an accident...)

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
