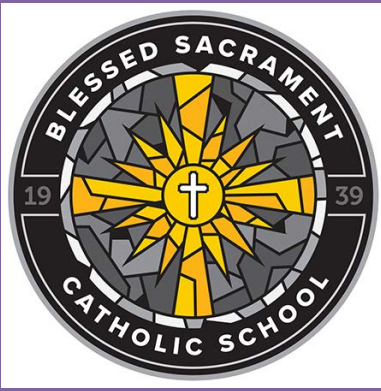

Pajama Drive



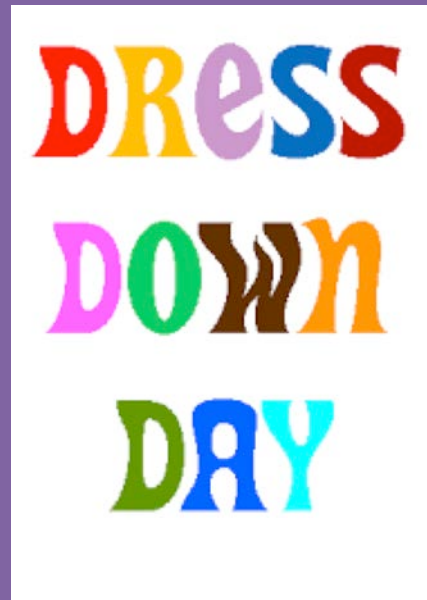
